Assessment	FAQ's
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Please follow the process as set out for the Licence you are being assessed for:

FFA 'C' Licence

I want to do my assessment?

Go to your member federation website and find the dates for the assessments taking place in your state and apply as directed.

What happens after I apply?

Your member federation will confirm your assessment appointment. If your preferred assessment window is full they will offer you an alternative appointment.

What do I need to prepare for my assessment?

Please complete an FFA Session Planner (you need power point for this) and submit by email one week prior to your assessment.

You will need to bring a hard copy of your session plan with you to your assessment.

Arrive 30 minutes prior to your assessment.

Will I get feedback after?

You will not get feedback immediately after your assessment. Your assessor will provide you with written feedback within 14 days of your assessment.

Can I discuss my feedback with my assessor?

Yes you will have an email contact for your assessor so you can arrange a convenient time to talk and discuss your feedback.

What if I dispute my assessment?

FFA Coach Education Assessment and Revalidation FAQ's

If you feel that your assessment has not been fair then you need to email advancedcoached@footballfedvic.com.au within 28 days of your assessment giving details of: -

- The time, date and venue of your assessment
- The name of the assessor
- Detailed reasons why you feel the assessment decision should be reviewed

FFA 'B' & 'A' Licence

I want to do my assessment?

The FFA offers 2 assessment options:

- Live Assessment
- Video Assessment

I want to do a live assessment?

Go to the FFA website and find the dates for the assessments taking place in your state and apply as directed.

What happens after I apply?

The FFA will confirm your assessment appointment. If your preferred assessment window is full they will offer you an alternative appointment.

What do I need to prepare for my assessment?

Please complete an FFA Session Planner and submit by email one week prior to your assessment

Bring a hard copy of your session plan with you to your assessment

Arrive 30 minutes prior to your assessment

Will I get feedback after?

You will not get feedback immediately after your assessment. Your assessor will provide you with written feedback with 14 days of your assessment

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Video Assessment

I want to do a video assessment?

You do not need to apply

What do I need to prepare for video assessment?

Use the FFA Self assessment session planner and film your session

Watch your film and undertake the self-assessment process on your plan.

If you are happy, submit your video and session plan as stipulated via the DropBox process.

Will I get feedback after?

Your assessor will provide you with detailed feedback notated against the video with 14 days of your assessment

Can I discuss my feedback with my assessor?

Yes you will have an email contact for your assessor so you can arrange a convenient time to talk and discuss your feedback
