

## 2019 SUMMARY OF CHANGES TO DOCKERTY CUP REGULATIONS

Rule of Competition	Subject Matter	Change/Amendment
1.3.3	Player Eligibility	<p>Regulation clarifies players who may have participated with another Club in any FFA Cup Rounds are no longer Cup tied during the DOCKERTY Cup.</p> <p>Scenario: A player who participated in the FFA Cup with another club has now been cleared to our club during the Transfer window.</p> <p>Resolution: Subject to Registration Regulations, the player may participate in the Dockerty Cup with the new club as they are no longer deemed team tied. However once a player has participated in the Dockerty Cup, they are deemed team tied in the Cup Competition.</p>
1.3.5	Player Eligibility	<p>MSL Club's must adhere to the MSL 1 Visa restriction which allows no more than four (4) Visa Players listed on a match Record.</p> <p>NPL Clubs musty adhere to he the NPL Player Points System.</p>
2.1	Substitution	<p>Each team may make up to three (3) substitutions during regular time.</p> <p>In the event a Dockerty Cup fixture enters Extra Time, a team may make a fourth substitution.</p>
2.1.5	Technical Area	Regulation to clarify the maximum amount of 11 persons in the technical area at any one time and the roles of those persons during a competition fixture.
2.4	Abandoned Competition Fixtures	Process which will be implemented if in the situation a fixture has been abandoned.
2.6.4	Amendments to Match records	Clarifies that the referee has discretion to amend the Match Record 30 minutes after the conclusion of the fixture and must be acknowledged by both clubs.
