NOTES

Functions - By-law 5, section 5

The Victorian Women's Standing Committee is to advise the Directors and the Chief Executive Officer on matters relating to women's Football. The Victorian Women's Standing Committee is to assist the Directors and the Chief Executive Officer in the conduct of all women's competitions sanctioned or recognised by the Association.

The Directors, the Chief Executive Officer or Members may refer any matter relating to women's Football to the Victorian Women's Standing Committee for advice. The Victorian Women's Standing Committee may give any advice requested of it, and may (whether or not requested to do so) make recommendations to the Directors and the Chief Executive Officer on:

- (a) measures to promote, develop and improve women's Football in the State;
- (b) measures to identify, and promote the development of, talented women Football players in the State;
- (c) consistency of application of rules, programs and structures, and equality of opportunity, for women in Football; and
- (d) any other matter relating to women's Football.

Membership - By-law 5, section 6

The members of the Victorian Women's Standing Committee will comprise persons elected or appointed according to By-law 1. The Standing Committee shall not have less than 6 nor greater than 12 members and only one member per zone.
